The website is still being updated with incorrect information and is not associated with the Village of Greenwood and is profiting off the Village of Greenwood. Grell stated we should move forward with the Cease and Desist since the editors for profiting off the website, Gerlach agreed. Sobota stated he has received calls that the clerk is not answering the phone. Sobota stated the number being called that is listed on their website is not the village office. Gerlach stated that it is correct but wholesale is going to be only 1% retail 4-7%. Sobota stated the document states we should budget in 2026 4-7% increase. Wilken and Gerlach agreed it should be increased 4-7% but this is just a discussion. Wilken stated it would be for 2026 and OPPD must vote on the increase first. Wilken made a motion to table. Sobota seconded. Roll call taken. All Ayes. Motion tabled.

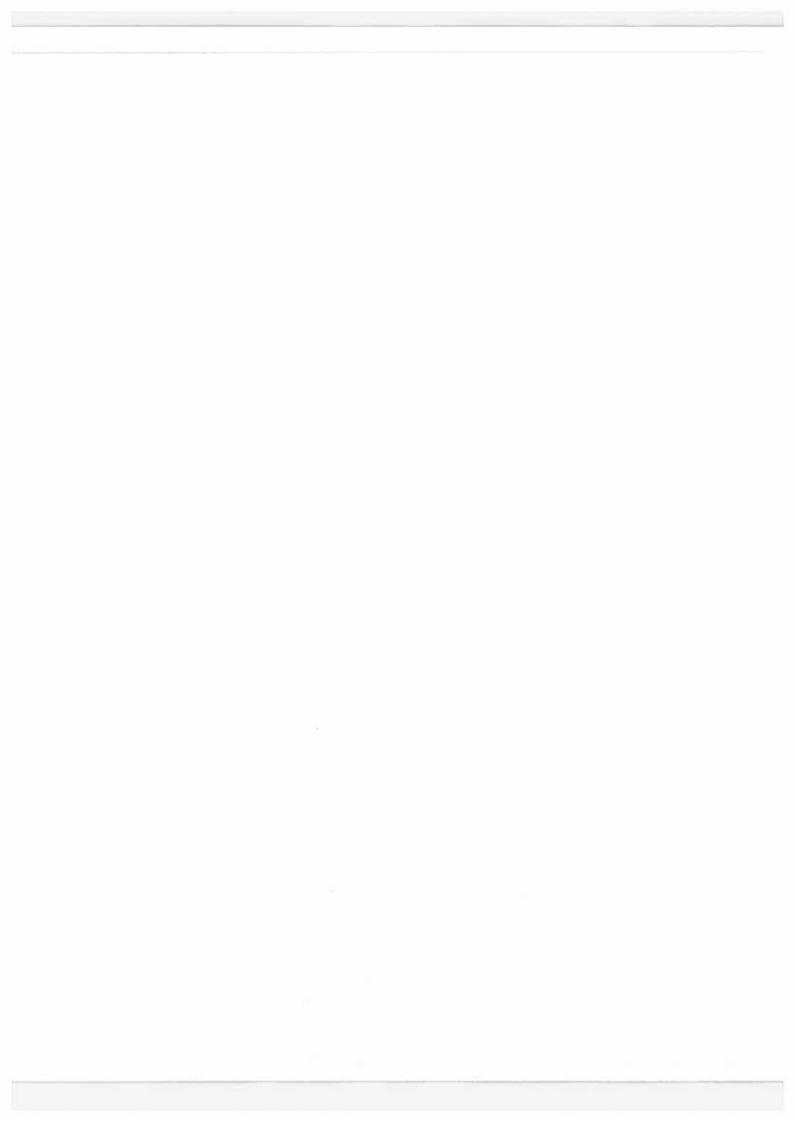

Greenwood Public Library Meeting Minutes November 6, 2025

Meeting called to order at 6:12pm. Members present were: Risney, Wrich & Hennings. The Open Meetings Act is posted in the meeting room for the public to view. Previous meeting minutes were reviewed & a motion was made to approve minutes with no corrections by Risney, 2nd by Hennings. Motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS

Parks & Rec has asked the Library to provide a Santa for Greenwood's December 6 holiday tree lighting event. A discussion of the available details ensued. It was decided that the Library would provide a Santa (Geary Leatherwood) in the Community Center from 1pm-2pm, depending on what best fits the Park's event schedule. The Library will also be open and will show a movie at noon and during the Santa event, and Friends of the Library will provide books, holiday pencils and candy canes to the kids who visit Santa. Later at the tree lighting event, hot cocoa & popcorn for free will donation to FOL will be available during the tree lighting ceremony. GVFD is also hosting a fundraising supper so the Library will firm up details & times at the next meeting.

Three requests for quotes on shelving for the children's sections were obtained by the Library Director, with an approximate cost of \$1,200. The Board will compare costs & discuss possibly repurposing an existing cabinet. Further discussion was tabled until the next meeting.

Holiday hours for the Library & patron attendance during holidays were presented for discussion. Hennings made a motion to close the library November 26-28 & December 25 for Thanksgiving & Christmas, as well as to consider closing early or closing on December 24 if patron attendance is low. Risney 2nd, Motion passed.

The Library's Trunk or Treat on October 18 was successful and had a good turnout despite the poor weather. The handmade Husker wreath was donated by a local artist for raffle. The split the pot raffle raised \$112 & the winner generously donated her winnings to the Library to cover 3D printer fees. A total of \$575 was donated to the Library for this event with expenses estimated at just under \$200 although some of that was donated as well. The final total profit of \$511 was given to the Village by the Library Director on Nov. 12 just before the Trustee meeting.

The Board reviewed YTD Library financials & discussed options for purchasing the greatly needed new computer. A motion was made by Risney to purchase a computer up to \$1200, including the data transfer fee. 2nd by Hennings. Motion passed.

The Library Director presented the Board with the upcoming annual renewal for the Teen Anime Club & Xbox subscriptions which were previously donated. Hennings made a motion to continue the subscriptions up to \$40 for both. 2nd by Risney. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

A new secretary is needed for the Library Board. Decision was tabled until the next meeting.

The requirements for needing a petty cash box were tabled until the next meeting.

Disposing of the remaining Book Sale materials was discussed. It was decided that any Board members available to take books will take them to Half Price Books in Omaha & return any gains to the Library Director.

The Library Director reviewed the recently attended NLA conference & summarized the topics & session discussions for the Board members. The Director had learned quite a bit at the conference and was able to network & share ideas with other Nebraska Librarians. The Director presented her newsletter article to the Board members & shared with us that she was able to keep her trip costs so low, that the TRLS scholarship she achieved had covered 90% of the total NLA conference cost.

Dear Village Board Members:

I ask that you appoint JEO Consulting Group, Inc. as the village engineer for 2026. We appreciate your confidence in JEO in the past, and we sincerely hope to continue our relationship.

JEO has provided services to the village in the past, and our staff has accumulated extensive "institutional knowledge" about your village and its infrastructure. This is extremely important as it provides the background information needed to evaluate what actions to take. Additionally, this knowledge often allows JEO staff to respond to questions about the village and its infrastructure without extensive investigation and research, reducing the time and cost involved in addressing routine matters.

Below is what you can expect from JEO as your village engineer. When a fee is involved for services, as noted in items two through four below, JEO will notify you before beginning work.

- IDENTIFYING AND PRIORITIZING INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS: If requested, JEO will attend a board or committee meeting to identify and prioritize infrastructure projects in the village. This planning may include prioritizing capital and infrastructure improvements, summary reviews of new permits and their potential impact, information on new regulations, recommendations on future planning, and input on potential funding sources. This does not entail detailed studies or evaluations but can be a valuable first step in assessing potential infrastructure projects' needs, priorities, and feasibility. There is no charge for JEO to attend this meeting or prepare and follow up on the meeting.
- APPLYING AND SECURING FUNDING: JEO will assist in applying for and securing funding, such as CDBG, USDA-RD, DWSRF, and CWSRF for potential infrastructure projects, as well as more non-traditional funding from both public and private sources. Additionally, JEO will provide the information necessary to complete the reporting requirements of any funding the village may secure. JEO has staff devoted to assisting municipalities in locating the funding that makes projects a reality. In some cases, having an appointed village engineer can expedite moving a project forward when grant and loan funding is involved. There may be a fee for some of these services, and we would be happy to discuss this with you.
- ROUTINE INFRASTRUCTURE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE: JEO will
 respond to questions about the routine operation and maintenance of the village
 infrastructure based on our prior knowledge of these facilities/systems. There is
 typically no charge for this service. However, in some instances a fee may be
 involved, such as site visits or research.

RETAINER AGREEMENT

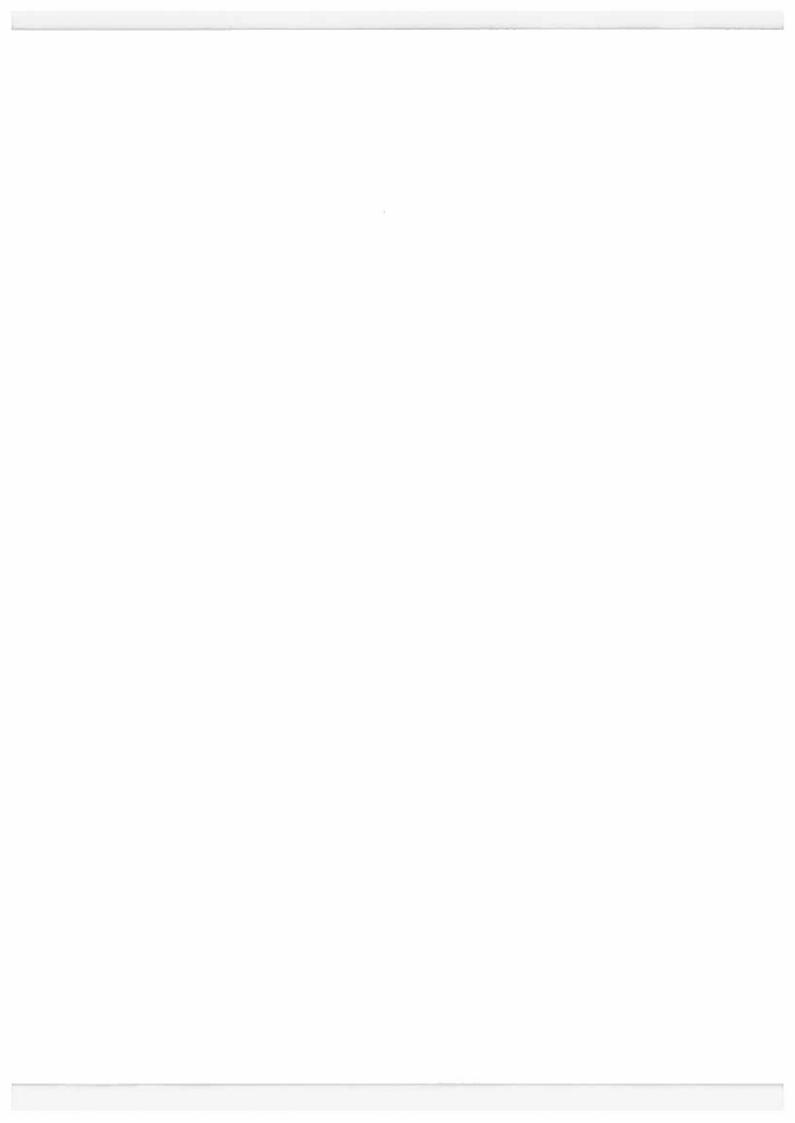

The Law Firm of Bromm, Lindahl, Freeman-Caddy & Lausterer, Wahoo, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as Law Firm, will provide legal services to the Board of Trustees of the Village of Greenwood, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as Greenwood, upon the following terms and conditions.

- 1. **Term.** The term of this Agreement shall commence as of the first regular meeting of the Village Board in December 2024 and terminate at the first regular meeting of the Village Board in December of 2026.
- 2. **Retainer.** \$850.00 per year. The first payment of \$850.00 to be due on or before December 31, 2024 and the second payment of \$850.00 to be payable on or before December 31, 2025.

3. Scope of Services Under Retainer.

- A. Law Firm is retained to provide advice and representation for all legal matters brought to Law Firm's attention by the Village and for which Village expressly requests legal services. The Village understands and agrees that Law Firm's representation does not include active monitoring of the Village's actions or inactions and Village agrees that Law Firm's representation is limited to those matters for which the Village actively consults with Law Firm about.
- B. Consultation in person at Law office and/or by telephone with Village Clerk and/or Chair of the Board of Trustees or other authorized Board Members as approved by the Board of Trustees. (limited to 15 minutes per month)
- C. Issuance of audit letter per auditor's request.
- D. Review all legal documents as to form only as presented by the Clerk. For clarification, drafting of documents, and edits will incur an hourly charge.
- Postage, photocopying and other related costs associated with Scope of Services Under Retainer.
- Representation. Law Firm will represent no client having an interest adverse to interest of the Board of Trustees of the Village. In the event Law Firm represents a client who subsequently has a conflict with the Village, the Village acknowledges that it may need to retain counsel other than Law Firm to represent its interests. Law Firm will not represent a claim or a matter adverse to the Village, nor will it represent a client in any matter adverse to the Village.



- 5. Services Not Included with Retainer. All matters not covered under Section 3.
- 6. Legal Fees, Costs and Other Charges for Services.
 - A. \$195.00 per hour for all attorneys in Law Firm performing legal services, except for all matters described under subparagraph B hereof;
 - B. \$215.00 per hour for attorneys in Law Firm performing legal services involving litigation or the threat of litigation, special services regarding zoning and subdivision matters, employment-related matters, and amendments to municipal code, zoning or subdivisions regulations;
 - C: \$75.00 per hour for Law clerks of said Law Firm;
 - D: \$175.00 per hour for travel time not associated with attendance at regular or special meetings of the Board of Trustees or of any other Board of the Village, if requested by the Chair of the Board of Trustees;
 - E. Actual costs incurred by Law Firm including but not limited to fees fixed by law or assessed by public agencies, long distance telephone calls, and postage, except for long distance telephone calls and postage for services included within Scope of Services, parking and other travel expenses, mileage, if travel is by personal auto, to be at rate established from time to time by Internal Revenue Service, photocopying, and other reproduction costs. Costs and charges will be at cost to Law Firm.
- 7. Consultants, Investigators and Experts. To aid in the preparation or presentation of legal matters for the Board of Trustees, Law Firm may hire consultants, investigators or experts. Said persons will not be hired without prior approval of Chair of the Board of Trustees and the agreement of the Board of Trustees to pay their fees and charges. The Law Firm will select and hire said consultants, investigators and experts.
- 8. **Billing Statements.** Law Firm will send Village monthly statements for fees and costs incurred pursuant to this Agreement. Said statements will be promptly paid by the Village pursuant to its normal claim handling policy.
- 9. **Discharge and Withdrawal.** The Board of Trustees of the Village may discharge Law Firm at any time. Law Firm may withdraw with the consent of the Board of Trustees, or for good cause. Good cause includes Village's breach of this Agreement, its refusal to cooperate with Law Firm or to follow Law Firm's advice on a material matter or any fact or circumstance that would render Law Firm's continuing representation unlawful or unethical. When services conclude, all unpaid charges will immediately become due and payable. After services conclude and upon payment in full of all outstanding fees and costs, Law Firm will, upon the Village's request, deliver all original documents in Law Firm's file to the Village, along with any funds or property of the Village in Law Firm's possession.
